|                 | <ul> <li>Youth substance use has decreased in Linn County, mirroring state and national trends.</li> <li>Dani noted that about one third of local tobacco retailers sold to minors during the 2022-2023 state compliance check. Most of these sales were vaping products.</li> <li>Rose noted that youth often have the perception that "everyone" vapes or uses marijuana when that is not the case. It is important to correct those misperceptions.</li> <li>Shannon stated that it is illegal for youth to buy vape pens but it is not illegal for them to carry them.</li> <li>Sue shared that vape pens can come in forms that are difficult to identify in schools, like highlighter vape pens.</li> </ul> |  |
