Discussion	Linn County Youth Data: Danette presented PowerPoint slides containing highlights of Linn County results from the 2022 Oregon Student Health Survey. 2,060 6 th , 8 th and 11 th grade students participated in the survey. In the future, all Oregon school districts will be required to administer the survey. Discussion:	
	 Youth substance use has decreased in Linn County, mirroring state and national trends. Dani noted that about one third of local tobacco retailers sold to minors during the 2022-2023 state compliance check. Most of these sales were vaping products. Rose noted that youth often have the perception that "everyone" vapes or uses marijuana when that is not the case. It is important to correct those misperceptions. Shannon stated that it is illegal for youth to buy vape pens but it is not illegal for them to carry them. Sue shared that vape pens can come in forms that are difficult to identify in schools, like highlighter vape pens.
