	This is the fourth year of the Linn Together Bottle Tagging campaign, which gives point-of-sale reminders to customers not to provide alcohol to minors. Currently, approximately 55 local convenience stores are tagged twice a year.
	Linn Together is expanding the campaign, with plans to tag each store three times per year. Beginning in August, Julie will bring a list of stores and tagging supply kits to Linn Together meetings.

	Those who are interested can take the supplies and instructions needed to tag a store of their choice. Julie provided a brief training on how to bottle tag, and Angie and Dani demonstrated using bottles of water.
